Elections:

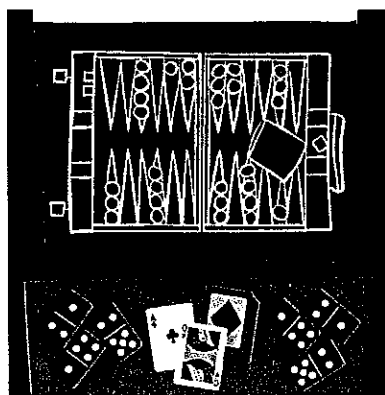
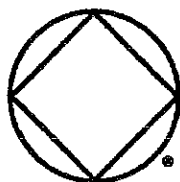
Treasurer’s chair is still open; Stewart is to take over duties until it is filled
