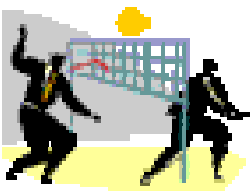

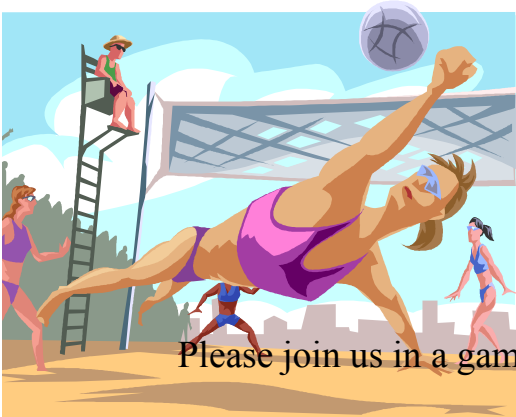
**From The Woodlands or Spring go I-45 North and exit FM 242 (College Park Drive), take a right and follow the directions above.**
